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### **Job's patience**

- Read James 5:7-11. From your knowledge of Job and the prophets reflect on some of the differences there are between the world's idea of patience and the Bible's. Give examples.
- What are the limits which Job seems to set for himself in his freedom of speech? (Examine especially Job 1-3) What might it look like in today's world for someone to overstep those limits?
- Examine Job's speeches in the rest of the book trying to categorise his various complaints. (Perhaps different members of the group each looking at one speech) What strikes you most?
- In your times of confusion and difficulty have you found yourself able to imitate Job?
- Jesus is described as a "man of sorrows" (Isaiah 53:3) and wrestles with God. How does this help us as we face troubles?
- How does this study affect the way that you will face future troubles?

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
